Reading books will be changed on a Monday. We are going back to physical reading diaries so please send these in as well. The expectation is that children read 3-5 times a week for about 10mins each time. I will still be sending a copy

of the weekly spellings for you to see. The children are not expected to practice writing these at home however having a regular read of this words would be helpful. You can also help your child by practicing times tables with them. I set work each week on Reading Eggspress and Mathletics so that is worth a check too:
